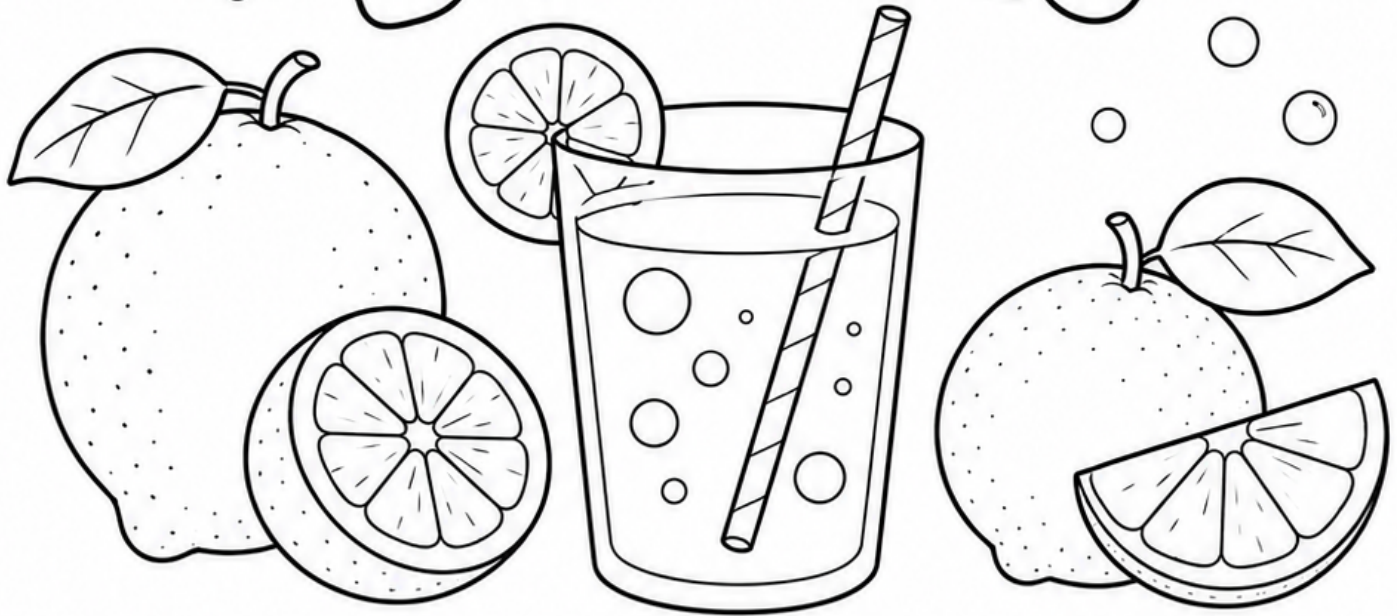

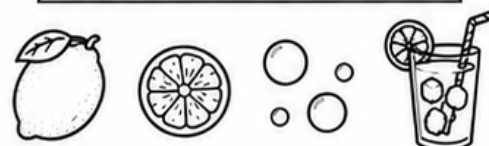


WELCOME, PARENTS!

TIPS FOR SUCCESS



BE CONSISTENT

A little practice every day is better than a lot all at once.



FOLLOW THEIR LEAD

Let your child choose, explore and lead. Real learning happens when they are engaged!



PRAISE OFTEN

Notice the effort! Positive words build confidence and motivate.



TALK ALL DAY

Use words during routines, play, meals, outings and reading.



BE PATIENT & KIND

Learning takes time. Mistakes are part of the process and that's okay!

Say the direction once without pointing. Pause and give your child time to listen. Repeat if needed.

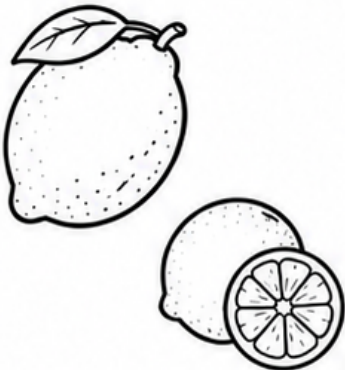

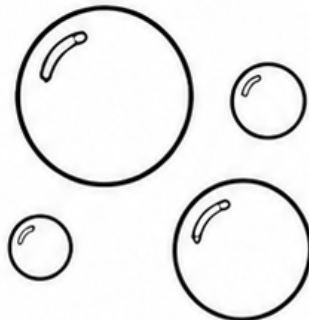
Make it a game! Take turns giving directions.

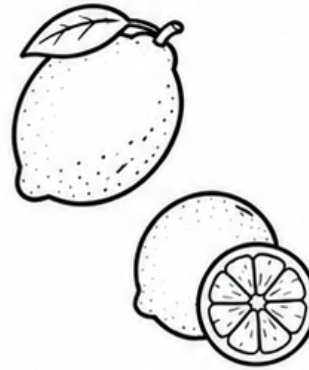

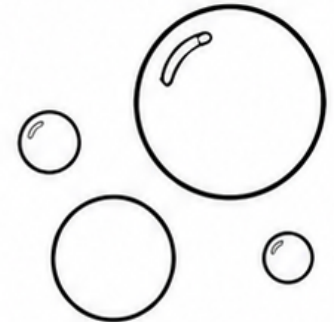
2 Color the bubbles.



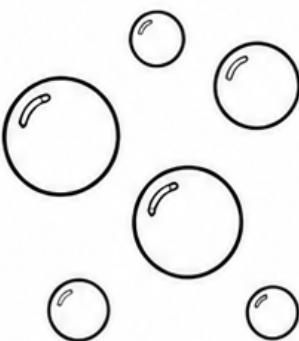
3 Point to the lime.



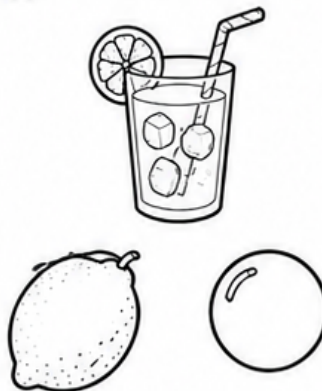
4 Color the bubble that is the biggest.

PARENT TIP

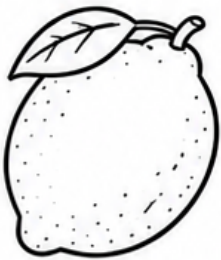
Follow your child's lead.

You: "Yes, a yellow lemon!"



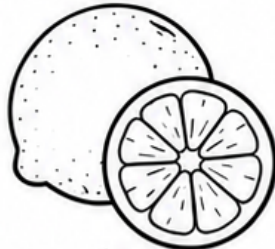
TRY THIS!

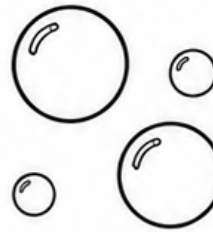

★ TODAY'S PARENT CHALLENGE ★

Ask and answer five questions together today!

Use: who, what, where, when, why.

Example: "Where is the lime?" "What color is the lemon?"
"Why do bubbles pop?"

WAYS TO EXPAND LANGUAGE

- Add one more word.
- Use describing words.
- Use "I see...", "I think...", "I like..."
- Encourage your child's ideas!



SPEECH PRACTICE!

Let's practice sounds while we play!



LISTENING GOAL

I can listen to sounds and imitate them.



SPEECH GOAL

I can practice sounds to help my words be clear.



PARENT TIP

Make it fun and keep it light! Celebrate every try. Model the sound, pause, and give your child time to imitate.

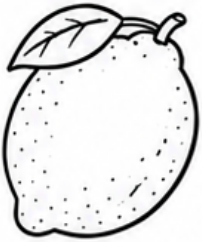


TRY THIS!

Practice these sounds in the car, in the bath or during play!

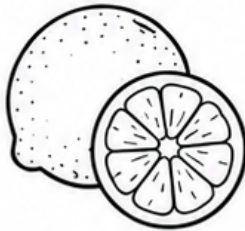
1 SOUND SPOTLIGHT: /L/

MORE WAYS TO PRACTICE /L/

- Blow through a straw and say "lllll."

- Put your tongue up behind your top teeth and say "lllll."



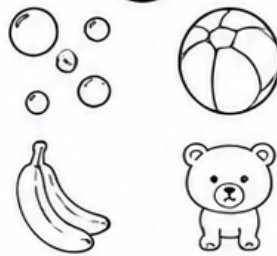
2 EARLY SOUNDS PRACTICE

Say each sound. Color the pictures that start with that sound.

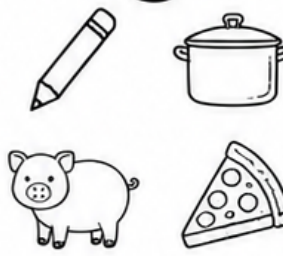

PARENT TIP

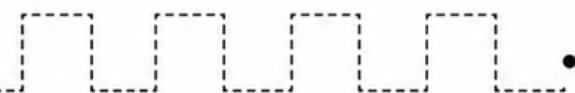
Praise your child's effort, not perfection! These activities help build the muscles needed for writing, cutting and buttons.

Choose one activity to do together every day.

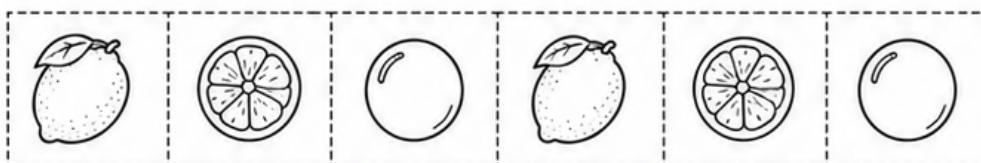
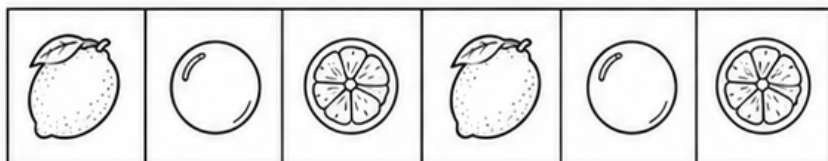
1 TRACE IT! Use a crayon or pencil to trace each line.

PARENT TIP

Give one direction at a time.
Use a calm voice and pause.
Praise your child for listening and trying!



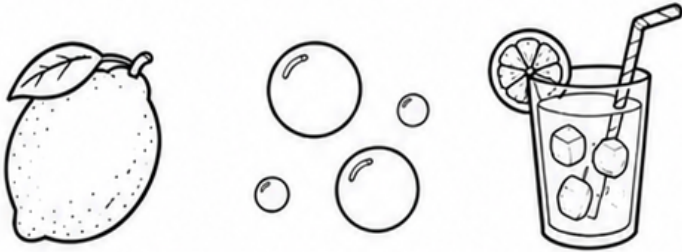

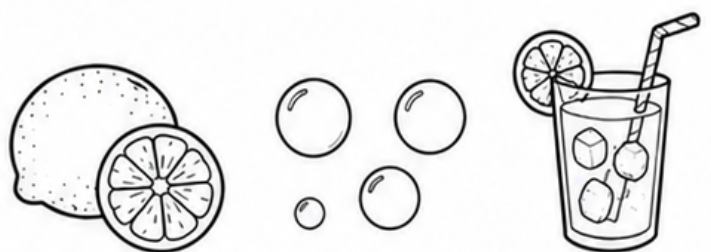

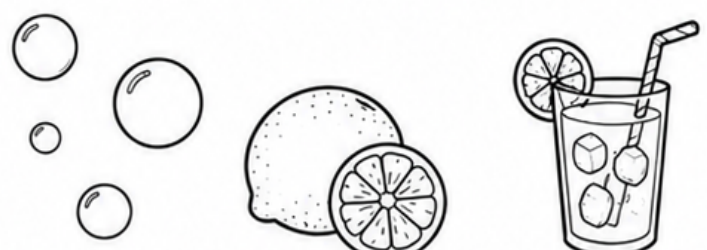

How many of each can you find?

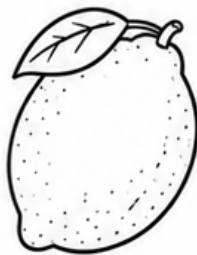


4 PLAY

Use the objects in pretend play! Make a lemonade stand, blow bubbles, or serve a drink!

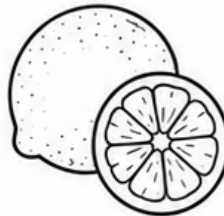
